## Remember!

- It is illegal for a person to operate a sound amplification device or a vehicle with a loud speaker within 1,000 feet of the polling place.
- No electioneering, Insignia, emblems, badges, etc., on clothing, hats, bags, etc. bearing references to a candidate, measure, or political party on the current ballot, within 100 ft of the polling place entrance by anyone, including voters.

## Preparing for Election Day

- Before Election Day, the Presiding Election Judge must complete these tasks:
  - 1. Contact the Alternate Presiding Judge and Clerks.
  - 2. Visit the polling place.
  - Check and review election materials. Cart of eSlates etc.

## Setting up the Polling Place

- Post the distance markers.
- 2. Post sample ballot display and informational signs such as the Voters' Rights Poster, Notice of Voter Complaint Information, No use of electronic devices (cell phones) in the polling place, etc. NOTICE OF VOTING ORDER PRIORITY
- Set up the voting equipment and turn it on.
- 4. Do NOT remove Blue Seal from JBC!
- 5. Set up the Voter Qualifying Table(s).

### Arrange Voting Equipment

Arrange the voting booths or equipment so that:

- Voters may cast ballots in secret.
- People waiting to vote will not disrupt people who are voting or enable them to see the ballots of those voting.
- Election Judge and poll watchers (if any) can monitor activity in the polling place, including the voting area.
- The voting area is adequately lit.

# Post Required Information in the Voting Booth

In each voting booth you **must** post:

- 1. Voting Instructions
- 2. List of Declared Write-In Candidates

#### **Emergency Ballots!**

We do not give them out anymore! Vote Centers—you can direct voters to the nearest polling place until we can reach you to fix any problem.

#### Oaths

- NEW Oaths! Statement of Officer/Oath of Officer must be filled out and can be signed by presiding or alternate judge at each polling place (Deputy Early Voting Clerks do not need to do this—only election day judges and alternate judges)
- Oath of Election Official (on timesheet)
- After taking the oath to serve as an election worker, you must wear a nametag.

### Miscellaneous Provisions

- Insignia, emblems, badges, etc: No clothing, hats, bags, etc. bearing references to a candidate, measure, or political party ON THE BALLOT may be worn within 100 ft of the polling place entrance by anyone, including voters.
- Influencing a Voter: Don't! It is a class B misdemeanor for anyone to indicate to a voter how the person desires the voter to vote.
- Media/Cameras/Press: They are not allowed in the polling place.

# People Allowed in the Polling Place

#### To enter the polling place you must be:

- A person accompanying a voter, such as:
  - a child under 18 years of age with a parent who is voting
  - a person assisting a voter (Oath)
  - a person acting as a voter's interpreter (Oath)
- A Poll Watcher who presents a valid Certificate of Appointment <u>and training</u> to the presiding Election Judge (<u>must wear a name tag</u>).

# People Allowed in the Polling Place

The following people, may enter the polling place, but <u>must be wearing a nametag</u>:

- State Election Inspectors
- Peace Officers summoned or appointed by presiding judge to preserve order
- Secretary of State and his/her staff

#### Qualifying a Voter

- Photo ID (State Approved List A)
- 2. Voter Certificate (not required but handy!)
- 3. Check photo, check expiration date, check name
- 4. Photo ID must not be expired more than 4 years to date, unless age 70 or over
- 5. Name must match exactly or be similar to the name on the VoteSafe computer
- 6. Look voter up on VoteSafe computer
- 7. Verify name matches the database or is similar (address verification is done on kiosk by voter)
- 8. Follow instructions on VoteSafe to check in voter
- 9. ADDRESS ON PHOTO ID DOES NOT HAVE TO MATCH!

#### **Election Judge Guide for Photo ID**

Effective 1-1-2018 (SB 5)

#### ACCEPTABLE CREDENTIALS FOR VOTING IN PERSON

The following forms of photo identification (List "A") will be accepted at the poll for voting purposes. A voter will be required to show one of the forms of photo identification at the polling location before the voter will be permitted to cast a vote.

NEW LAW (SB 5): Persons over 70 years old may use List "A" ID for the purpose of voting no matter how long it has expired.

If a voter does not possess and cannot reasonably obtain an ID from List "A" below, see reverse side of this document.



Texas driver license and DPS Receipts issued by the Texas Department of Public Safety (DPS)

- unexpired or expired less than 4 years before the date of presentation
- Not accepted if "Limited Term" or "Temporary Visitor" appears on the face
- of the card, which indicates this person is not a U.S. Citizen.



United States military identification card containing the person's photograph —unexpired, marked "INDEF" or expired less than 4 years before the date of presentation. Includes: Department of Defense (DoD) Common Access Card (CAC) or Uniformed Services ID cards or DoD Civilian Retiree Cards or Veterans Affairs ID cards (VIC) or Veteran Health ID card (VHIC)



Texas Election Identification Certificate (EIC) issued by DPS — unexpired or expired less than 4 years before the date of presentation

 EICs do not expire for persons age 70 or older (For more information on the EIC application process www.txdps.state.tx.us/DriverLicense/electionID.htm)



United States citizenship or naturalization certificate containing the person's photograph

Texas personal identification card issued by DPS — unexpired or expired less than 4 years before the date of presentation Note: some Personal ID cards may not Expire

- Persons aged 60 or older may be permanent and marked "INDEF"
- Not accepted if "Limited Term" or "Temporary Visitor" appears on the face of the card, which indicates this person is not a U.S. Citizen.



#### United States passport and passport card

— unexpired or expired less than 4 years before the date of presentation



#### Texas handgun license

issued by DPS — unexpired or expired less than 4 years before the date of presentation - Concealed License are still valid if unexpired or expired less than 4 years before the date of presentation



Permanent Exemption — If the voter has applied for and received permanent Exemption to the Photo ID requirement, they will provide a voter registration certificate with an (E) notation next to VUID number. Example: 1030000000 (E)

\*If a voter has obtained an acceptable form of photo ID, but did not bring it to the polling place, the voter may vote provisionally.

The voter may "cure" by appearing to the Burnet County voter registrar's office within six (6) calendar days of election day and present an acceptable form of photo ID, or qualify for one of the exemptions (disability, natural disaster, or religious objection to being photographed).

# Permanent Exemption

- Allows voters with a disability rating of 50% or more to obtain a permanent exemption to showing a photo ID.
- Application can be obtained at Voter Registrar's office, and voter will attach paperwork from Social Security Administration or Veteran's Affairs.
- Good for as long as the voter is registered in the same county.

## Permanent Exemption

If the voter has a permanent exemption, and they present their voter registration certificate with the (E) next to the VUID, they vote normal. They do not need to complete a Reasonable Impediment Declaration.

#### Qualifying a Voter...continued

#### Addresses!

- You should not compare the address on any ID (List A or List B) to the address on the list of registered voters.
- -THEY ARE NOT REQUIRED TO MATCH!!!
- The voter confirms their address on the kiosk is right or wrong.
- This allows the voter to update their registration records.

# Qualifying a Voter...continued

• If the voter confirms that the Kiosk has their address wrong, the Kiosk will direct to have the voter fill out a Statement of Residence form. Once filled out and checked over for legibility, etc., the voter will vote a regular ballot

# Reasonable Impediment Declaration

Prescribed by Secretary of State Section 63.001(i). Texas Election Code

#### REASONABLE IMPEDIMENT DECLARATION

Instructions: If a voter appears on the official list of registered voters, but does not possess an acceptable form of photo identification under Section 63.0101 (a) of the Texas Election Code (which, for voters aged 18-69, has expired by no more than four years, and for voters aged 70 or over, is or is not expired, if otherwise valid) ("Acceptable Photo ID"), and cannot reasonably obtain an Acceptable Photo ID, the following steps shall be taken by the election officer to allow the voter to cast a regular ballot:

- 1. Present this form to the voter, and ask the voter to provide a copy or original of one of the following forms of identification listed in Section 63.0101(b) of the Texas Election Code:
  - a. a certified domestic (from a U.S. state or territory) birth certificate or a document confirming birth admissible in a court of law which establishes the voter's identity (which may include a foreign birth document);
  - b. a current utility bill:
  - c. a bank statement;
  - d. a government check;
  - e. a paycheck; or
  - f. a government document that shows the voter's name and an address (which includes the voter's voter

NOTE: The address on the identification presented is not required to match the address recorded in the official list of registered voters.

NOTE: If on Election Day, a presented voter registration certificate indicates that the voter is appearing at the incorrect polling place, the voter should be directed to the correct polling place.

- 2. Ask the voter to complete this form by entering their name, and then ask them to review the "Voter's Declaration of Reasonable Impediment", indicate their impediment, and sign their name.
- 3. Ask the voter to return the completed form to you. Neither you nor the election judge may question the voter concerning the reasonableness of any claimed impediment. The election judge should enter the date and then sign on the space provided on the declaration.
- 4. Either you or the election judge shall fill in the voter's Voter Unique Identification Number ("VUID") in the appropriate box or affix a sticker that contains that information across the box, and note on the combination form that the declaration was used by the voter. Either you or the election judge should indicate on the "To Be Completed By Election Official" form what type of document the voter provided by checking the appropriate box. Either you or the election judge should fill in the Date of Election and Location fields.
- 5. Allow the voter to cast a regular ballot.


NOTE: This form may also be used if a voter voted provisionally and does not possess and cannot reasonably obtain an acceptable form of photo identification, and appears at the county voter registrar's office within six (6) calendar days after election day to execute a reasonable impediment declaration and present one of the supporting forms of identification, in accordance with Section 65.0541 of the Texas Election Code. In that instance, the county voter registrar should follow steps 1 through 4 above, but substitute references to "election judge" with "county voter registrar", including signing where the election judge would otherwise sign on the space provided on the declaration.

# Copy of or Original of Other Government Document, Including the Voter's Voter Registration Certificate

- MUST include voter's name and an address. REMEMBER: The address on the supporting ID does not have to match the voter's registration address.
- If the voter's name appears on the list of registered voters in the precinct, but does not match exactly to the ID provided, a "Substantially Similar Name Affidavit" must be completed by the voter.
- Must be issued by the federal government, a federally recognized tribal government, or a state or local government in the U.S.

#### **Examples of Other Government Documents:**

- Driver's licenses from other states
- ID cards issued by federally recognized Native
   American tribes (if the ID card contains an address)
- DPS Receipts (without a photo)
- Current or expired voter registration certificates
- For voters aged 18-69, expired Texas DPS-issued driver licenses or personal ID cards (over 4 years).
- Examples of Documents NOT included:
- Social Security Cards (no address)
- State College IDs (if no address)
- State/Federal Employee ID Cards (if no address)
- Library Cards (if no address)

#### **Copy of or Original Current Utility Bill**

- It may be a copy or printout.
- To be current, the utility bill must be the most recent version or at least dated within two (2) months of the date it is presented to an election official.

#### **Copy of or Original Bank Statement**

• It may be a copy or printout.

#### **Copy of or Original Government Check**

 It may be an original check or a copy of the check.

#### **Copy of or Original Paycheck**

• It may be a copy or original of the check.

## Copy of or Original of a Certified Domestic Birth Certificate



# SIMILAR NAMES

The law states that the voters name on their ID must match exactly <u>OR</u> be substantially similar to what we have on the voter registration database (VoteSafe)

### Similar Name Matches

- Election workers will need to fully compare the voter's name listed on VoteSafe to the name listed on the acceptable form of ID.
- There are only three possibilities:
- Name on VoteSafe and ID are identical.
- 2. Name on VoteSafe is **"substantially similar"** to name on ID.
- 3. Name on VoteSafe <u>does not match and is not similar</u> to name on ID. (it's a totally different name)
- 4. Ask for help if you can't determine what to do!

### Names are Identical

If the voter's name on the Pollbook is identical to the name on the ID, the voter will proceed as usual.



# Assisting Voters with Disabilities

 Voters who are physically unable to mark the ballot and/or cannot read the languages on the ballot may receive assistance.

# **Ensuring Accessibility**

- Polling places must accommodate voters who have disabilities. No person should be denied the right to vote because they have restricted mobility, vision, speech or hearing impairments.
- Accommodating people who have disabilities is mostly a matter of sensitivity and common sense.

# Etiquette Reminders

- Be sure you recognize that physical disabilities are not cognitive impairments. For example, assume a person using a wheelchair can read, write, and follow directions as well as anyone who walks into the polling place. Don't fall into the common insensitivity of underestimating people.
- It is okay to use words like "see" and "hear" and "walk" while talking with someone who has one of these impairments.
- Take your time and be considerate of the person you are qualifying or assisting. Adjust your pace to theirs.
- Talk directly with the voter, not the aide, assistant, or interpreter.
- Ask before helping.

### PERMANENT EXEMPTION

During the cure period, voters with a disability may apply with the county voter registrar for a <u>permanent exemption</u> in the county. The application must contain written documentation from either the U.S. Social Security Administration evidencing applicant's disability, or from the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs evidencing disability rating of at least 50 percent. The applicant must also state that he/she has no valid form of photo identification. Those who obtain a disability exemption will be allowed to vote upon display of voter registration certificate reflecting exemption.

### TEMPORARY EXEMPTION

During the cure period, a voter may apply for a temporary exemption at the county voter registrar's office for voters who have a consistent religious objection to being photographed OR who do not have any photo identification as a result of certain natural disasters as declared by the President of the United States or the Texas Governor.

Who Qualifies: Under Section 64.009 of the Election Code, a voter who is "physically unable to enter the polling place without personal assistance or likelihood of injuring the voter's health" may vote at the polling place entrance or curb.




# Curbside Procedure

Poll worker or voter's helper needs to provide the photo ID, language preference, Party for Primary, and whether headphones are needed.

Poll worker will go through the check-in process on the Kiosk and sign "curbside" as the signature. Once the label prints from the Kiosk, poll worker scans the label on the JBC and gets the access code. Once the ballot is on the eSlate screen, it is removed to be taken out to the voter.

The Kiosk label is put on the Curbside combination sheet and the sheet is carried along with the eSlate, out to the voter where the poll worker verifies the ID of the voter, has them sign the combination sheet under the label and then gives them the voting machine to vote their ballot

- 2. Press ENTER to choose that digit.




