## **ORDINANCE NO: 228-010924**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BERTRAM ORDERING AN ELECTION TO BE HELD ON MAY 4, 2024, FOR THE PURPOSE ORDERING THE ELECTION OF THE MAYOR AND TWO (2) ALDERMEN; MAKING PROVISION FOR THE CONDUCT OF SUCH ELECTION ACCORDING TO APPLICABLE PROVISIONS OF LAW; PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION OF AN APPROPRIATE ELECTION NOTICE HEREAFTER; AND OTHER PROVISIONS INCIDENT TO AND RELATED TO THE PURPOSE HEREOF.

WHEREAS, the terms of office of the Mayor and two (2) aldermen expire on May 4, 2024; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that the City Council call a general election to fill the position of Mayor and two (2) alderman positions; NOW THEREFORE:

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BERTRAM AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. THAT an Election be held on May 4, 2024, which date is the uniform date available for municipal elections for which sufficient time elapses for the holding of an election after passage of this Ordinance. General election shall be held to elect the Mayor and two (2) Aldermen:

SECTION 2. THAT the election shall be held at the Joann Cole Mitte Memorial Library, 170 North Gabriel Street, Bertram, Texas, and all persons qualified to vote in the City of Bertram under the election laws of the State of Texas shall be allowed to vote therein. Said Election shall be held and the polling places shall be open from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Burnet County has County Wide Polling Locations known as Vote Centers, you may vote on election day at the nearest polling location that is open no matter where you are in the County. You do not have to vote at your home precinct.

SECTION 3. THAT notice of the election shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Bertram by publication of a Notice of Election as required by Chapter 4 of the Texas Election Code at least once not earlier than the 30<sup>th</sup> day or later than the 10<sup>th</sup> day before the election day. In addition, notice of the election shall be posted as required by the Texas Election Code.

SECTION 4. THAT early voting shall commence on the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of April, 2024 and shall conclude on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2024, and be conducted at the AgriLife Auditorium and Texas Tech University, on weekdays, during the regular hours of business as stated below:
